

NATURE COAST INTERGROUP MEETING MINUTES

DECEMBER 14TH, 2014.

CHAIRPERSON RICK T. opened the meeting with a moment of silence followed by the Serenity Prayer.

SECRETARY:- Denis S. read the minutes of the previous meeting and they were accepted as read.

TREASURER:- PAIGE B. presented a finalized report for November and it was accepted. She reported a nett income from the Gratitude Dinner of \$571.99. The partial report for December was reviewed and one correction was suggested as follows:- the name of the petty cash account be changed to "change fund".
