

NATURE COAST INTERGROUP MEETING MINUTES

TRUSTEES:- Denis said that the Chili Cook Off was fantastic and he was very impressed. He thanks everyone who worked on it. Janet said she is assisting Paige in getting the tickets and flyers out to the groups for the Gratitude dinner. Sandy shared that everyone had a good time at the Chili Cook Off. That many people really liked the park. She has heard great things about the Gratitude Dinner. Sandy said that many are having a very positive experience with the events.

HOTLINE:- Amanda read the report for the hotline and wants to keep it for another month. There were 47 total calls with 4 wet, 1 alanon, 2 detox and 38 about meetings.

WEBMASTER:- Steve N. reported the NCI website up until October 24th has had 970 visits. There were 672 unique visitors with 398 making multiple visits. The average visitor viewed 2.36 pages per visit. 66.8% of the visitors were new with 32.2% being returning visitors. The bounce rate for the site's first page is down from 82% to 65% which means more people are actually spending time on the site once they arrive. The ten most visited pages were: Where and When, Meeting Information Page, Meeting by Day (with Monday, Friday and Sunday being the most looked at), District Home Page/ Minutes, Meeting by Location, Information Links, Calendar, Journal, Contact Information, and NCI Minute. The ten most frequently downloaded documents or information were Where and When, Journal, Chili Cook Off Flyer, Responsibility Statement, Workshop Topics, Gratitude Dinner Flyer, Legacies Information, Traditions,.mp4 by Chet, State Convention 59 Flyer, and Young AA Hotline Phone Number.

JOURNAL:- Lynn was unable to attend.

EVENTS:- - Lynn G. the Chili Cookoff was last Sunday. About 89 people attended with 129 tickets sold. A good time was had by all. The kids really enjoyed the Pinata. Renee was a wonderful speaker. A lot of people could identify with her life story. Our next event is the Gratitude Dinner, it will be at St. Benedicts on November 8th. Doors open at 4, dinner, speaker is at 6. Please remind all your groups that we need donations of Hams and Turkeys. Hams and Turkeys can be dropped off around 2pm. Also, we could use more volunteers.
