

ONATURE COAST INTERGROUP MEETING MINUTES

October 30, 2016

CHAIRPERSON Steve N. opened the meeting with a moment of silence followed by the Serenity Prayer.

Monday night Yana meeting that moved to the 1st Baptist and Wednesday night women's meeting moved to the Presbyterian Church no one showed. A few missed calls per still trying to figure out the phone. Monday night Men's meeting will take the phone for November. They also updated the 12th step call list and all meeting lists are current as of October.
