

NATURE COAST INTERGROUP MEETING MINUTES

December 11, 2016

CHAIRPERSON Rick T. opened the meeting with a moment of silence followed by the Serenity Prayer.

TREASURER:- Paige read the final report for November 2016 of a beginning balance of \$3048.37 an ending balance of \$3739.41. The treasurer's report was read and accepted. The December Preliminary was presented and final numbers will be out for the next meeting.

TRUSTEES:- Janet had nothing to report. Sandy attended the Longtime Speaker's Meeting and said they didn't receive a lot of cooked baked goods but received a lot of store bought. 46 people in total. Bill was unable to attend. Denis advised he attended the Longtime Speaker's Meeting and it seemed to be a good time.

WEBMASTER:- Steve N., Webmaster, so far this month (11 days) there have been 682 web sessions by 416 unique visitors viewing 2170 pages for 3.18 page views per session. The top ten pages visited were Meetings general, meetings by day (in order- Friday, Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Saturday, Wednesday, Thursday), meetings by location, calendar, district 28, minutes, links, what's a meeting like, newcomer information, and is aa for you. The top five downloads were traditions.mp3, journal, where and when, state convention flyer and responsibility statement, 50% of the users accessed the site via desktop or laptop, 43% from phones and 6% from tablets.

New Business: The lack of space for storage needed to be discussed. It's a 5' storage area and trying to get to anything to get it out for the events is rather difficult. A motion was made and passed to do an inventory of the storage with the NCI trustees and the event's chair before making a decision to upgrade to a larger space. Steve N. presented the 2017 Schedule for NCI as January 8th, February 5th, March 5th, April 2nd, May 7th, June 4th, July 16th, August 6th, September 10th, October 8th, November 5th and December 3rd. A motion was made and accepted on the schedule. Paige B. presented the 2017 budget with an income of \$10424.50 and a total expense of \$10232.25. Leaving us with a positive asset of \$192.25. A motion was made and accepted.
