I'm very grateful that Bill W. and Dr. Bob continued to serve Alcoholics Anonymous until the day they passed away instead of stopping after a few years. And I'm very grateful that Bill W., 'facing up to his own mortality, a General Service Conference assumed the leadership which had fallen to the co-founders.

HOW DO I SIGN UP????

After conferring with your sponsor, call the Intergroup Office Monday through Friday from 9AM to 4PM at 633-0052 or 724-2247.

Give your name, phone number (cell numbers are okay) and where you reside since all 12-Step calls are assigned by the city. Be sure to indicate when you are available and then do your very best to say yes when you are called. You might want to review the 12-Step Guidelines on the brochure. Also look for any relevant workshops; besides your sponsor.
