

NATURE COAST INTERGROUP MEETING MINUTES  
MARCH 2020

OPEN:-Chair Ingrid opened the meeting with a moment of silence followed by the Serenity Prayer.

ROLL:- Six groups were represented as follows:-Attitude Adjustment, Crystal River, Freedom House, Holder, Women's Friendship and Real Happy Hour.

SECRETARY:- Denis S read minutes of previous meeting and they were accepted as read.

TREASURER:- Mike F sent a report showing a net loss for the month of \$172 and a closing balance of \$6931.63. It was noted that the planned printing of the Journal every month instead of every two months would reduce the surplus going forward as planned. Mike's report was accepted pending audit at year's end. The prudent reserve is set at \$6000.

HOTLINE:- Chris G sent a report that the phone was quite busy and that all calls had been answered. During the month Chris had called Trustee Dean B for help with a call that seemed to have some legal issues around it. Chris indicated that he would be interested in the position of Hotline chair in the future.

WEBMASTER:- Steve N reported 4596 visits to the Website for the month. A motion to include Detox information in the Website was passed. Steve thanked Linda A and Corey P who volunteered to be on the Website Committee.
