CONCEPT 12

Bill Wilson's **Towns Hospital Transformation**

Based upon Bill's story as described in AA Comes of Age, pages 62-64.

During his last hospital stay in December 1934, Bill W. underwent a sudden change in personality which released him from his alcoholic obsession.

Bill described it as entering upon "a new world of consciousness". He was soon to read of similar experiences described by William James. James is recognized as the founder of modern psychology in America. Bill read The Varieties of Religious Experience which confirmed that what he had experienced was real and had been experienced by others. Bill also soon realized that this personality change was effective because the message was passed from one alcoholic to another.

Bill W. died 50 years ago but we continue to carry the message from one alcoholic to another and AA lives on.
